Organisation	Amount	Project
Apex in the community	£3000	The A-Race also known as the adventure race is a family race with a twist! Teams, consisting of one adult and one child, will be faced with a variety of fun challenges along the track, all of which will need to be completed and get their race card stamped before they can continue to the next station.
Dacorum Community Trust	£3000	Table top cookers and second hand beds for clients allocated temporary and permanent accommodation.
Dacorum Mencap	£2000	To arrange a social event at Hemel Hempstead Football Club for members of Dacorum Mencap plus all adults with a learning disability in the Dacorum area.
Alternatives Pregnancy Crisis	£3000	To set up a Hemel Hempstead Pregnancy Crisis & Support Centre. To open a Mother & Baby Charity Shop in Hemel Hempstead town centre and offer counselling from the same location.
Superheroes Ltd	£3000	The 'Who Are You?' project will address the increasingly mixed cultural demographic in Hemel Hempstead and how young people are adapting to and accepting these. HYOC2020 creates an opportunity to deliver a project that highlights our own individual heritage, as well as those of others to increase acceptance and understanding.
Dacorum Community Choir	£900	To give three major concerts each year and approximately 16 local performances, which take place at Day Centres and Care Homes (eg Centre in the Park), at community clubs (eg Musical Memories and the Evergreen Club), and local events such as Remembrance Sunday in the Old Town High Street.
Herts Inclusive Theatre	£1520	To run a Summer workshop with the aim to educate participants in the cultural aspects of circus performance in line with the Hertfordshire Year of Culture.
Mediation Hertfordshire	£2800	From Conflict to Wellbeing - 'Conflict to Wellbeing' is an initiative that will create awareness throughout the Dacorum Healthcare sector of the services provided by Mediation Hertfordshire (funded by Dacorum Borough Council) to resolve conflict.

Potten End Village Hall	£9825	Window replacement to bring their wonderful village hall up to the needs of the 21st Century.
Tring Together	£2960	Tring Together is a charity that aims to bring people together to 'Enjoy life in Tring'. They offer wellbeing for the residents of Dacorum, via a diverse range of free activities promoting outdoor exercise using the wonderful heritage & countryside around Tring. In addition, to mark the Anniversary of VE day, they are planning a very special commemoration day in Spring 2020.
Electric Umbrella	£3000	They would like to take their members into schools across Dacorum and through cross curriculum music based/song writing workshops led by their professional musicians and members with learning disabilities, broach subjects including equality and diversity, disability awareness, and wellbeing. Through trying something new they would develop creative thinking and innovation and problem.
Herts Baseball Club	£3000	To help fund the repairs of damage caused by vandalism around the venue in order to make it safe and suitable for youth and adult players alike. The repair work also aims to reduce the risk of future vandalism. Improving the facilities will in turn increase the club's capacity to attract new players.
Make a Move Dance Academy	£200	Their project will focus on children within the community that would benefit from dance classes; by making friends, building confidence, having someone to confide in, learning new skills and having fun.
Bovingdon 10	£300	To organise a yearly 10k and 3k fun run around Bovingdon.
Saturn Way Supported Housing	£300	A new lawn mower and new plants for the flower beds and hanging baskets.
Dacorum School Sports Network	£425	To buy a Primary Badminton Racket Pack set to support them to deliver a new competition, and to loan the pack out to schools to practice, increasing the amount of time pupils are participating in physical activity.

D-lab studios	£3000	Grant to replace the bulb in their laser cutter.
Gobstoppers	£3000	Shakespeare at the castle project to put on performances with teenagers at Berkhamsted Castle.
Chaulden Neighbourhood Association	£3000	Kitchen refurbishment for community centre.
Home-start Herts	£3000	Project to support parents suffering from mental health issues.
Dacorum Heritage Trust	£3000	Project to commemorate the end of World War II, including an exhibition, workshops and local events.
BEEE Creative	£3000	#TAG is an intergenerational dance programme in Dacorum, Watford & Three Rivers from January - September 2020 that will celebrate the Hertfordshire Year of Culture 2020. It aims to increase individual sense of personal wellbeing & belonging
Open Door Berkhamsted	£3000	Grant to purchase a kiln and damp cupboard for a new project to run pottery workshops.
Waterways Experiences	£3000	To purchase and install solar panels
DENS	£1649	To widen the range of activities offered by the DENS Open Space. This will introduce new activities to participants who often have very limited experience of such events, often feeling it's 'not for them'. By introducing the participants to a range of experiences in a supportive, group environment it may widen their interests and continue to participate in the future.
Great Gaddesden Cricket Club	£9000	A grant towards the cost of replacing the cricket pavilion roof.
Hemel Hempstead Rovers FC	£500	A grant to pay for new equipment to help extend the training season.
The Swan Youth Project	£500	A grant to pay for a new software package to help keep accurate records of how many young people are attending.
Dacorum Sports Club for the Disabled	£250	To provide new sports and equipment and recruit members and volunteers.
The Spikey Sanctuary	£500	Equipment and incubators for orphaned hedgehogs in their intensive care unit.
Dacorum Community Dance	£490.10	A grant to pay for new dance equipment and banners to advertise the scheme.
