THE BOROUGH OF DACORUM (HOLLIDAY STREET AND WATERSIDE, BERKHAMSTED)
(RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

NOTICE is given that Dacorum Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council in order to prevent a likelihood of danger arising through obstructive parking, proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in parts of Holliday Street and Waterside, Berkhamsted.

The proposals (*indicated by red lines on the plan below*) will introduce no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) in parts of Holliday Street and Waterside, Berkhamsted.
