

Evelyn Sharp House

Supported Housing Scheme

Evelyn Sharp House in Adeyfield is a purpose built supported housing scheme for people who wish to continue to live independently whilst having access to support close by.

We also offer a Flexicare service at this scheme where people who need a little additional support can receive it from an on-site care management team.

Where is Evelyn Sharp House?

Evelyn Sharp House is a short walk to local shops at Queen's Square. There is a chemist, supermarket, newsagent, a café and takeaways, as well as the community centre. There are bus stops where you can catch a bus to the town centre.

The nearest doctors' surgery is Everest House, which is about 15 minutes' walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 58 self-contained flats in the scheme, with an additional 20 flats in Field Road nearby.

What facilities are there?

Evelyn Sharp House has a launderette, communal lounge, sun room and communal gardens for tenants to use. We also offer Flexicare at this scheme.
