

Two Beeches Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Two Beeches in Grovehill, Hemel Hempstead, is a purpose-built supported scheme.

Where is Two Beeches?

Located on the corner of Washington Avenue and St Agnells Lane in Grovehill, the main entrance is in Avon Square.

The nearest doctors' surgery is Grovehill Medical Centre, which is less than 10 minutes' walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 46 self-contained flats across two floors. The building has two lifts.

What facilities are there?

There are two communal lounges, with a laundry for tenants' use. The scheme benefits from a hairdressers' room and a mobility scooter store.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

There is a coffee morning every Monday and bingo on Fridays. The social committee organise regular trips out to the seaside, for pub lunches or arrange evening meals at the scheme. There is also an Age UK day centre which some of the tenants attend. The Dacorum Indian Society use one of the lounges for Yoga on a Thursday morning, again tenants can take part if the wish. There is a visiting hairdresser and chiropodist. We also run tablet courses to help tenants get online as well as a range of other **Tenant Academy** courses.
