

Willow Edge Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Willow Edge in Kings Langley, is a purpose built supported scheme.

Where is Willow Edge?

The scheme is in Kings Langley

The nearest doctors' surgery is The Nap Surgery, which is less than 5 minutes' walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 38 self-contained flats across two blocks, and ten dispersed properties in Blackwell Road.

What facilities are there?

There is a communal lounge and a laundry for tenants' use as well as a shelter for mobility scooters.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

Tenants have regular coffee mornings and fish and chip nights once a month. We also run tablet courses to help tenants get online as part of our **Tenant Academy**, and a range of other free courses are available.
