

## DACORUM BOROUGH COUNCIL

### THE BOROUGH OF DACORUM (BURY HILL, LOCKERS PARK LANE AND MELSTED ROAD, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that Dacorum Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the above Order which comes into effect on 24 August 2020:

The general nature and effect of the Order is to ban vehicles from waiting between 8:15am and 5:30pm on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) in Bury Hill, Lockers Park Lane and Melsted Road around the junctions of those three roads and extending:

- a) north into Lockers Park Lane outside ‘Rosehaven’ and ‘Springfield’;
- b) south into Lockers Park Lane for approximately 26.5 metres;
- c) west into Melsted Road outside and opposite No. 2 Melsted Road and ‘Rosehaven’ (including at the rear of No. 2 Lockers Park Lane); and
- d) east into Bury Hill outside and opposite The Collett School.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
