Newsletter 10 – Christmas Update

Dear Resident,

What a year it has been, here is a note to update you for our plans over Christmas;

Site works will cease today (Friday 20th December) and will resume again on Monday 6th January.

During this time we will have 24hr security who will be undertaking regular patrols of the site.

Before we go, we will leave the site clean, safe and secure so as to not cause you any unnecessary disruption over the Christmas break.

When we come back in the New Year, we will resume works where we have left off; we have all but finished the known works within the DLCO. Any additional investigation and treatment will be focussed on Meadow Road.

This year we have:

- Hand dug over 1500 inspection pits to check for buried services
- Drilled over 16,000m of boreholes
- Moved nearly 600 tonnes of chalk by hand
- Grouted over 800 boreholes
- Pumped 7900m³ of grout in total, equivalent to **79** double decker buses parked end to end!
- Undertaken 710 investigative and validation probes including 16 validation probes within houses
- Reinstated 28 Properties and gardens
- Handled over 1,755 grout deliveries
- Worked over 100,000 man hours
